Dear Comstock Families,

Last night at a press conference, Robert Gordon, the Director of the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, announced a statewide, three-week "Pause to Save Lives." Under his authority within the Michigan Public Health Code (MCL 333.2253), Director Gorden ordered all Michiganders to follow specific rules and regulations to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19 (see attachment). These directives take effect on Wednesday, November 18 and impact the operations of public schools including Comstock.

The immediate influence on our district is minimized by the fact that our Board of Education had already proactively placed students and staff on a virtual-only instructional model since Thursday, November 12. However, the new regulations will change our path forward in the following ways:

- The orders are in place beginning Wednesday, November 18 through Tuesday, December 8. Even though our Board had targeted a return to face-to-face instruction for Monday, December 7, the earliest date for this to occur is now Wednesday, December 9.
- All athletic and interscholastic practices, competitions, tournaments, and activities are suspended.
- The Education For Employment (EFE) Auto program at Comstock High School is closed during this time.
- The Board-approved one-on-one counseling or small-group tutoring sessions are also suspended.
- Effective immediately, meal distribution will move to Tuesdays and Fridays, beginning Tuesday Nov. 17th. Adults may pick up meals for children, and we ask that adults pick one location and stick with it, and not visit multiple sites. Children will receive a full seven (7) days of school meals while the district is in full remote learning. All sites are closed on Friday Nov. 27th. The distribution schedule is as follows:
 - CHS: 12-2pm Tue/Fri 3 days of meals on Tuesdays and 4 days of meals on Fridays
 - Pavilion: 12-1:30pm Tue/Fri (per the posted stops on the district website -<u>www.ComstockPS.org/eat</u>) - 3 days of meals on Tuesdays and 4 days of meals on Fridays
 - o CES: 12-2pm Fridays ONLY during packet pickup days 7 days of meals on Fridays

- As we learn of more details or changes to these orders, I will update our community in a timely fashion.
