What's New on the Menu

We're thrilled to be introducing new kid-favorite recipes to the menu at Comstock this fall reflecting some of the latest food trends. Here are just a few of the new meals we're excited about heading into this year.

- Fun Lunches as a 3rd entrée choice at the elementary buildings. These will be known as Choice #1 (green), Choice #2 (orange) and #3 (blue)
- Baked Ziti, Teriyaki Dippers with Fried Rice, and a Strawberry Yogurt Parfait for our K-5 learners

Universal Free Meals

Again for the 2023-24 school year, all Comstock students will have free breakfast and lunch meals while they are at school. This is part of "Community Eligibility Provision", which we have participated in since 2017. It is important to note that families should still complete an Electronic Benefits Form (EBF), which helps ensure ongoing state funding and can qualify our buildings for other special programs like free summer meals. If families have already received an email or letter stating their free educational benefit, they do not need to fill out an EBF. Parents or guardians can complete the form online, through the district website, or in person at any school office.

• Menus and Nutrition Facts at Your Fingertips <u>Comstock Nutrislice Menus</u> Through Nutrislice, an innovative app, students, parents and faculty have access to school menus, including nutrition information, allergens and photos. Nutrislice can be downloaded for free from the App store (iOS) or Google Play (Android) and is available on desktop and mobile devices. Menus are also available at <u>comstockps.nutrislice.com</u> All menus will be available by Thursday August 24th.

• Special Diets/Allergies MDE Special Diet Statement

Just because a student has a known allergen listed in the student information system, doesn't mean that the kitchen knows about that allergen and has approval to make a modified meal for the student. Each child must have an approved MDE Special Diet form filled out by a medical professional before we can make menu changes in the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program. Each office has a copy of this form and both sides must be filled out and returned back to Holly Wait for approval. The district does not make accommodations for religious or personal dietary preferences. All allergy or special diet questions may go directly to Holly via email or at 269-250-8928.



Adult Meals

The school meals program is a federal grant for students and does not include discounted meals for adults. Adults are welcome to grab a lunch during student meal times for \$5.25, or order from out Adult Lunch Menu. Each kitchen has a copy of our special adult lunch menu and can give you assistance in ordering those meals each day. If you need a school meal account set up to make deposits and track your purchases, please send an email to Holly with your name, building you would be at during lunch, and DOB (mm/dd/yyyy).
